## Gate Hours (Subject to change)

Located on SR 1008 (Beaver Creek Road) two miles south of US 64, Ebenezer Church (currently open year-round) is one of four day-use areas at Jordan Lake.

## Facilities

From 8am to 5pm, Monday thru Friday, call the main park office at 919-362-0586 for emergencies. For after hour emergencies call Chatham County Sheriff's Department at 911.

## Emergencies

All regulations are enforced throughout all areas by the Division of Parks and Recreation and are pursuant to G.S. 143B-135.16 of the N.C. Administration code. Thank you for observing these regulations.

Please **recycle** all aluminum cans. Recycling bins are located at the boat ramp and in the campground.

- Park-wide speed limit is 25 mph or less. All motor vehicle laws apply within the park.

- Gathering firewood is not permitted.

- Unlicensed scooters and golf carts are prohibited.

- All pets must be on an attended leash six feet in length or less and may not be left unattended.

- Swimming permitted in designated areas only. There are no lifeguards on duty.

- Firearms and weapons **prohibited**.

- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

- The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is **prohibited**.

Make your visit a safe and rewarding experience. Some of our regulations are posted for the protection of our visitors and our park. A complete list is located at the entrance station.

## Boat Ramps

There are six boat ramp lanes and a restroom open 24 hours a day.

## Day Use Area

All day use areas close at night and are separate from boat ramps.

## Beach Area

The beach area consists of a swim beach, restroom/change rooms, a four-table picnic shelter, a sand volleyball court, individual picnic sites, and the one-mile Ebenezer Church Trail.

## Picnic Area A

Area A has a 12-table picnic shelter with fireplace and restrooms, individual picnic sites, and the one-mile Old Oak Trail.

## Picnic Area B

Area B has a four-table picnic shelter, individual picnic sites, and a restroom.

## Fees (Subject to change)

A day use fee is charged on weekends in the months of April, May and September and every day from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The day use ticket is good at all day use areas within Jordan Lake State Recreational Area.

Day Use ..... \$6 / Vehicle  
Senior Citizen (62 or older) ..... \$4 / Vehicle  
Season Pass (*free day-use entry into Falls, Jordan and Kerr Lakes all year!*) ..... \$50 / Year
