



PILOT MOUNTAIN STATE PARK

The Sauratown Trail leads onto private property. Please be mindful of this while hiking here.




From the Mountain Section:
- To Bean Shoals Access (Surry County) - 10 Miles
 From US 52, take the Pinnacle exit and follow the signs to Horne Creek Farm. The park entrance is .4 miles past Horne Creek Farm.
- To Ivy Bluff Access (Yadkin County) - 20 Miles
 Take NC 67 to the town of East Bend. From Main St., turn right onto Fairground Rd. Turn right on Shady Grove Church Rd. Turn right on Shoals Rd. and follow it to the park.

The Mountain-to-Sea Trail through the park starts at the southern end of the Corridor Trail and travels to the Mountain Trail, past the family campground on the Grindstone Trail, and heads east out of the park on the Sauratown Trail below the park office. Follow the white circle blazes.
