
Pilot Mountain State Park

From the Mountain Section:

To Bean Shoals Access (Surry County): 10 mi. From U.S. 52, take the Pinnacle exit 29 and follow the signs to Horne Creek Living Historical Farm. The park entrance is 0.4 mile past Horne Creek Living Historical Farm. Parking lot is 0.3 mile past park entrance on left.

To Ivy Bluff Access (Yadkin County): 20 mi. Take N.C. Highway 67 to the town of East Bend. From Main Street, turn right onto Fairground Road. Turn right on Shady Grove Church Road. Turn right on Shoals Road. and follow to the park.
