Rules & Regulations

Make your visit a safe and rewarding experience. Some of our regulations are posted for the protection of our visitors and our park. A complete list is located at the entrance station.

- The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is **prohibited**.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Firearms and weapons **prohibited**.
- Maximum number of people (including children) allowed per site at any time is six (12 on duplex sites).
- All pets must be on an attended leash six feet in length or less and may not be left unattended.
- All tents and vehicles must be placed inside landscape timbers. No vehicles are to be parked in roadway or on grass.
- Campsites are for overnight camping only. Campsites cannot be rented for picnicking or day use.
- Swimming permitted in designated areas only. There are no lifeguards on duty.
- A camper must be at least 18 years old to register and at least one camper must occupy the site each night it is rented.
- Unlicensed scooters and golf carts are prohibited.
- Checkout time is 3 p.m. Check in time for a reservation is 4 p.m. You may not be able to enter the campground until 4 p.m. if your site was occupied the night before.
- Gathering firewood is not permitted. Firewood is for sale at the entrance station or from the ranger on duty in the off season.
- Maximum stay is 14 days in a 30-day period.
- Park-wide speed limit is 25 mph or less. All motor vehicle laws apply within the park.
- Dumping sink and shower water from RVs onto the ground is prohibited.

All regulations are enforced throughout all areas by the Division of Parks and Recreation and are pursuant to G.S. 143B-135.16 of the N.C. Administration code. Thank you for observing these regulations.

Emergencies

From 8am to 5pm, Monday thru Friday, call the main park office at 919-362-0586 for emergencies. For after hour emergencies go to your nearest campground host or call Chatham County Sheriff's Department at 911. Campground hosts are found on sites A23, B72 and C51. **Campground hosts can open the front gate for emergencies only.** Hosts are not authorized to let anyone inside the park gates after hours. Not all camping loops have hosts in them.

Front Gate

The front gate is **closed and locked** at posted closing times for your protection. There will be no exiting or entering the gate after this time and the combination will NOT be given out. All visitors not spending the night will need to be out by closing time. If you leave the park and do not return before closing time, you will not be able to re-enter. If you have an emergency, see camp host at site listed above. Please notify camp hosts for **emergencies only**.

Gate Hours (Subject to change)

May - September 8 a.m. – 10 p.m.
March, April and October 8 a.m. – 9 p.m.
November - February 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
Closed Christmas Day
Note: Campground may be closed during winter months.

Camping Registration

The entrance station is open to register campers seven days a week during the peak season, which is June through August and on weekends in April, May and September. In the off-season (October - March), you may set up camp on any available site, and a ranger will register you there. Site availability will be posted at the entrance station and changes on a daily basis.

Occupancy

Campsites must be set up immediately upon completion of registration. You must occupy the campsite each night for which the campsite is rented. Occupancy is defined as having at least one person and primary camping equipment, such as a tent, set up on the site. Coolers, tarps, lawn chairs, etc. do not meet this requirement. The colored camping tag must be clipped to the site post. The colored camping tag does not substitute for occupancy. The maximum number of people per site is six (including children), 12 on duplex sites.

Fees (Subject to change)

A day use fee is charged on weekends in the months of April, May and September and every day from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The day use ticket is good at all day use areas within Jordan Lake State Recreational Area.

Day Use \$6 /Vehicle
Senior Citizen (62 or older) \$4 /Vehicle
Campsite without electricity \$20 /Night
Campsite with electricity \$25 /Night
Duplex site without electricity \$37 /Night*
Duplex site with electricity \$47 /Night*
Season Pass (free day-use entry into Falls, Jordan and Kerr Lakes all year) \$50 /Year

*Duplex sites are designated sites that can accommodate two camping units. These sites are identified with a sign and are circled on the map. The same fee is charged regardless of how many camping units are on the site.
