## Front Gate

The front gate is **closed and locked** at posted closing times for your protection. There will be no exiting or entering the gate after this time and the combination will NOT be given out. All visitors not spending the night will need to be out by closing time. If you leave the park and do not return before closing time, you will not be able to re-enter.

## Emergencies

From 8am to 5pm, Monday thru Friday, call the main park office at 919-362-0586 for emergencies. For after hour emergencies call Chatham County Sheriff's Department at 911.

## Rules & Regulations

Make your visit a safe and rewarding experience. Some of our regulations are posted for the protection of our visitors and our park. A complete list is available at the park office.

- The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is **prohibited**.
- Firearms and weapons **prohibited**.
- Park-wide speed limit is 25 mph or less. All N.C. motor vehicle laws apply within the park.
- All pets must be on an attended leash six feet in length or less and may not be left unattended.
- Horses are not permitted inside park boundary.
- Swimming is not permitted at New Hope Overlook boat ramp.
- Bicycles are allowed only on park roads, not on trails.
- All campers must be registered.
- All tents must be located on the gravel pad in a designated campsite.
- Gathering firewood is not permitted. (Firewood is available at the ticket booth or from rangers on duty.)
- Maximum stay is 14 days in a 30-day period.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Camper check out time is 3 p.m.

Please **recycle** all aluminum cans. Recycling bins are located at the boat ramp and in the campground.

All regulations are enforced throughout all areas by the Division of Parks and Recreation and are pursuant to G.S. 143B-135.16 of the N.C. Administration code. Thank you for observing these regulations. A complete list of regulations is located at the entrance station.

## Gate Hours (Subject to change)

May - September ..... 8 a.m. - 10 p.m.  
 March, April and October ..... 8 a.m. - 9 p.m.  
 November - February ..... 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.  
 Closed Christmas Day

**Note:** Campground may be closed during winter months.

## Camping Registration

The entrance station is open to register campers seven days a week during the peak season, which is June through August and on weekends in April, May and September. In the off-season (October - March), you may set up camp on any available site, and a ranger will register you there. Site availability will be posted at the entrance station and changes on a daily basis.

## Occupancy

Campsites must be set up immediately upon completion of registration. You must occupy the campsite each night for which the campsite is rented. Occupancy is defined as having at least one person and primary camping equipment, such as a tent, set up on the site. Coolers, tarps, lawn chairs, etc. do not meet this requirement. The colored camping tag must be clipped to the site post. The colored camping tag does not substitute for occupancy. The maximum number of people per site is six.

## Fees (Subject to change)

A day use fee is charged on weekends in the months of April, May and September and every day from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The day use ticket is good at all day use areas within Jordan Lake State Recreational Area.

Day Use ..... \$6 /Vehicle  
 Senior Citizen (62 or older) ..... \$4 /Vehicle  
 Primitive Campsite ..... \$13 /Night  
 Season Pass  
*(free day-use entry into Falls, Jordan and Kerr Lakes all year)* ..... \$50 /Year
